### We are trained to work with people who have a Learning Disability who may .....

- Hurt themselves or others when they get upset
- Have mental health difficulties
- Have physical disabilities that need specialist treatment



#### What we do

We will try and help you to use the same services as other people

Our job is to help you live happily and safely in your home



We can help you if you are worried, upset or angry and hurting yourself or other people.

This can be called 'behaviour that challenges'




We work with you and the people who support you



We will try to find out why you are so upset



If you need medication we will make sure it is right for you



We can help you to find things to do at home and in the community



We will write a plan to make sure everyone knows the best way to support you We can help if you need special support because of your physical disability or other health difficulties.

This can be called 'complex health needs'



We can help if you have trouble swallowing or choking



We can help you to communicate



We can help you with movement and walking, and help you to feel comfortable and safe



We will write a plan to make sure everyone knows the best way to support your health needs
